# RULES

#### 1 – DENOMINATION:

The A.S.D. SPORTINACQUA with the agreement of C.M.A.S. and F.I.P.S.A.S. is pleased to invite you to 1st Round Finswimming World Cup 2021, that will hold in Lignano Sabbiadoro (UD) from 19 to 21 March 2021.

#### 2 – COMPETITION PLACE:

The competition will be held in Bella Italia Sports Village – Viale Centrale, 29 – Lignano Sabbiadoro (UD) – ITALY – Number 8 lanes, 50 meters long Olympic swimming pool features a constant depth 2,10 m.



#### **3 – PARTICIPATION RULES AND RACES:**

The competition, following the Finswimming International Regulation, and this Particular Regulations, includes the following races and categories:

Senior (Cat. A) (18 years old and over)

M/F: 50AP, 50SF, 100SF, 200SF, 400SF, 800SF, 50BF, 100BF, 200BF, 400BF, 100IS, 4x100SF RELAY, 4x100 BF MIXED RELAY.

Junior (Cat. B + C + D) (12/17 years old)

M/F: 50AP, 50SF, 100SF, 200SF, 400SF, 800SF, 50BF, 100BF, 200BF, 400BF, 100IS, 4x100 SF RELAY, 4x100 BF MIXED RELAY.

• Swimming style: AP= apnea; SF= surface finswimming; BF= bifins; IS=immersion.

#### THE PROGRAM WILL BE CONFIRMED AFTER THE CLOSING OF REGISTRATIONS THROUGH THE PUBLICATION OF THE START LIST AND MAY BE CHANGED DUE TO TECHNICAL NEEDS.

NO LIMIT OF PARTICIPATION TO "FREE TEST RACES" OR OUT OF RACE IN OFFICIAL PROGRAM.

For the participation in World Cup program, please refer to points 1.9, 1.10, 1.11 of the CMAS Finswimming World Cup Swimming-Pool rules Version 2020/01.

The organisation will accept from each country only one judge in the official jury.

#### 4 – ENROLMENTS:

The competition is governed by CMAS Finswimming Rules, by CMAS Finswimming World Cup Swimming-Pool Rules, by the "Detailed protocol for the holding of international Finswimming competitions taking place in Italy" (attached) and by the present Specific Rules that every athlete - with his/her enrolment - affirms to know and agrees to follow strictly.

#### 1. Registration



For registration the website is https://www.sportdata.org/cmas Opening date of registration is from Friday 26 February to Sunday 14 March.

This year, the registration applies for World Cup program and Free test races.

#### 1. Registration Tutorial:

For registration, you need an account.

Users who already have registered an account <u>in our system</u> (only registered in sportdata. Account in the previous base, sport.cmasoffice.org aren't valid now), please re-use your Account. In this case, you can also re-use all competitors, coaches, referees and officials data.

For event registration of your competitors, coaches, referees and officials, please follow these steps:

- Log in with your Account.
- Check your team data. Please check if the data is correct and up to date.
- Enter or change the data of your competitors, coaches, referees and officials.
- In the event, the calendar goes to the event you want to register for, click on the "Registration" button of the event you wish to register.
- On the bottom of the entries site, you will see the functions to make new entries.
- Register your competitors/teams in categories, as well as your coaches, referees and officials.
- All your registrations will go first on a waiting list to validate them. After the payment process is finished, your registrations will be approved, and you will be notified by email.
- You can find an overview of all your registrations at "My current entries". There you can also find the amount you have to pay and the provided payment method.
- Please also check out the "Other Items" section of the event. The organiser may also provide here additional purchase items, like transport, accommodation, etc.

- 2. Fees of registration

It's not necessary to buy a CMAS licence to participate in World Cup 2021. The system will take into Account only Temporary licence CMAS. CMAS licences won't be checked.

# **CMAS FEES**



For each round or Golden Final, each competitor must participate and pay CMAS fees, fixed annually by CMAS.

• 20,00 € for participation fees by each round (include annually temporary licence).

Please note that relays members' names must be entered during the registration process based on individual registration even if they swim the only relay. According to the rules, relays' composition can be changed on-site before the beginning of the competition.

These fees will be paid only at the end of the registration process online by credit card, or bank transfer includes SEPA.

### **ORGANISATION ENGAGEMENT FEES**

Euro 20,00 for the club, Euro 7,00 for each distance or free test races and Euro 14,00 for each relay. The fee paid for not-performed races won't be reimbursed. Also, relays must be declared with time on the enrolment forms. Late enrolments may be accepted with a fine of Euro 50,00.

Payment of engagement fees should be made by bank transfer

#### **5 – PRELIMINARY PROCEDURES:**

All sports documents of the swimmers will be checked exclusively from hours 5,00 p.m. to hours 8,00 p.m. of Friday 19/03/2021 at the Bella Italia Sports Village swimming-pool Viale Centrale, 29 – Lignano Sabbiadoro (UD).

#### 6 – FORFAIT of COMPETITORS:

The team's leader will be announcing the competitor's absent <u>five days before starting competition</u>. For every swimmer missing in the heat without communication, the club will be liable for a fine of Euro 50,00.

#### 7 – REGISTERED TIME:

Timekeepers with Electronic System.

#### 8 – INDIVIDUAL PRIZES:

Medals will be given to the first, second and third competitor in each individual race and relay in the categories Girls, Boys, Woman, Men and Mixed. At the prize-giving, each swimmer MUST WEAR his TEAM UNIFORM.

MEDALS WILL BE TAKEN ONLY DURING AWARD CEREMONY. PLEASE RESPECT THE PROGRAM

#### 9 – CLASSIFICATIONS AND CLUBS PRIZES:

There will be a classification for Individuals, Clubs, National Teams and Countries.

<u>Individual</u>: there will be, for every distance, four different individual classifications for men, women, juniors boys and girls. Swimmers registered by Clubs or National Teams are in this classification.

<u>Club</u>: the total amount will make the individual point's general classification (men and women, junior and senior only registered by clubs). Four separate Club Classification will also be made for seniors men, seniors women, juniors boys and juniors girls.

<u>National teams</u>: the total amount will make the individual point's general classification (men and women, junior and senior). Four separate National Teams Classification will also be made for men, women, juniors boys, juniors girls.

Countries Ranking:

a) the Countries Ranking will be made following points 1.9 and 1.11 by the total amount of the individual points (men and women, junior and senior) of National Teams.

b) if National Federation doesn't enrol its National team, the best two results by the club following points 1.9 and 1.11 at each distance are at each category (men, women, juniors and seniors) Countries ranking.

#### **10 – DOPING CONTROL:**

Doping Control follows the international rules of WADA and CMAS Anti-doping code.

#### **11 – CHECK EQUIPMENT:**

Equipment will be checked directly to the starting point during the competition

#### 12 - RESPONSIBILITY:

A.S.D. SPORTINACQUA, C.M.A.S., F.I.P.S.A.S., the Competition Director, the Competition Officers and

The Chief Judge are not responsible for accidents or damages caused to people and things, before, during or after the competition.

#### 13 - SPECIAL NOTES:

This program could be modified for organisation cause. <u>Swimmers must be available for the Start</u> Judge with their complete equipment at least 10 minutes before the race start.

Are allowed only bi-fins and swimsuit homologated by CMAS

A swim cap is mandatory. The organising club reserved to accept and insert an athlete or a relay at any time at own discretion, in or outside the official classification, on request by the participating club. Any other rule concerning the competition could be found on the C.M.A.S. Finswimming Rules.
