


THE CITY OF TOMSK

The city of Tomsk is the administrative centre of the Tomsk region, Russia, located on the Tom River. The city is the oldest in Siberia and is a major educational, scientific and innovation centre that includes 9 universities, 15 research institutes, a special economic zone of technical innovation type and 6 business incubators. Tomsk is a member of the Association of Siberian and Far Eastern cities.

The city is rich in monuments of wooden and stone architecture of XVIII-XX centuries.


The city's population is 575 352 people (2020).

OFFICIAL COMPETITION POOL AND TRAINING



Aquatics Centre Zvezdniy is a unique sports facility in Tomsk. The Zvezdniy is one of the largest sports complexes in Western Siberia. The main object of the sports complex is an Olympic-size swimming pool, 50 meters in length. Thanks to modern cleaning technology, the sports complex provides crystal-clear water for activities and recreation all year round.

The total area is 14697.7 square meters. There are two swimming pools in the complex: one is 50x25 m, and the other is 25x25 m. The depth of the first one is 2.15 m, of the second one is 3.2 m. The pool is equipped with an automatic timing system, «Omega», and a full-colour video display. Pools are divided into 10 lines. There are three sports halls: hall of dry swimming, dance hall, gym. There are also four saunas, massage rooms for the recovery of athletes.

The centre has a conference hall for 60 seats. There are two video-audio control

booths in the «Center of swimming» that can create and edit video and audio signal

and transmit information through satellite links. During sporting events, the complex can

accommodate up to 1400 spectators.

PARTICIPATION

1. GENERALITIES

CMAS and FISU have the pleasure to invite you to the VI Finswimming University Competition in TOMSK from 07th to July 11th 2021.

2. PARTICIPATION:

In this competition can participate:

- The Universities Teams recorded by Universities.
- The Universities Teams registered by National Federations affiliated to CMAS under the label of the country. When it had received authorisation from his University for the athlete, it also competes under his University's name added to the system's country registration.

In this way, University registration regarding FISU instructions is a priority. The possibilities of registration by the national federations being considered second when the option exists.

The National Federations can receive the different Universities' agreement so that the athletes can be registered and also compete under the University's colours.

To participate,

• The participant has the Finswimming CMAS sport license bought by his national federation.

or

• Upload in the registration system, medical certificate (*available in the download section of SportData website*) and certificate of proof for the individual insurance to cover the participation. Even if the documents signed and with stamps are uploaded, the athlete must present the original document to the organising committee at arrival.

Each University Teams should enter the athletes in the system https://www.sportdata.org/cmas/.

When National Federation enters athletes in the system <u>https://www.sportdata.org/cmas/</u>, it should also fulfil the field "University name" when the athlete received his University's authorisation to compete under his name. If the National Federation didn't receive this authorisation, this field stays empty.

Each University team should comply with the Championship Rules, Safety Requirements set by the Organisers, and all other CMAS Rules and Regulations.

3. ELIGIBILE PARTICIPANTS:

1. <u>Eligible to participate in this competition, all competitors must satisfy the following conditions:</u>

- a) Be a student of the University (no matters the nationality) they represent.
- b) Be at least 18 and less than 25 years old December 31st, the year of the event (For 2021, athletes born between 01/01/1996 and 31/12/2003).
- c) The students who are currently officially registered as proceeding towards a degree or diploma at a university or similar institute whose status is recognised by their country's appropriate national academic authority.
- d) Former students of the institutions mentioned in c) who have obtained their academic degree or diploma in the year preceding the event.





2. Individual dossier to submit on arrival

The dossier must be presented to the CMAS Technical Delegate and must include:

- a) If a student
 - A document proving that s/he has satisfied the conditions usually required in his/her country for entrance to a university or similar institute;
 - Student card or certificate from the appropriate national academic authority certifying that the competitor is currently officially registered as proceeding towards a degree or diploma at a university or similar institute whose status is recognised by their country's appropriate national academic authority.
- b) If a former student:
 - Proof of the date s/he obtained his/her final academic degree or diploma;

4. RULES AND RACES:

Each University team can enter not more than two (2) competitors to each individual event and not more than one University team to each relay.

All University teams should bring two (2) national flags (m. 2,00 x m. 1,00). CD with National Anthem is not required because it is playing only FISU Hymn during Awarding Ceremonies.

Swimming-pool races:

Apnea: 50m Surface: 100m, 200m, 400m, 800m, Bifins: 50m, 100m, 200m Relay: 4x100m surface, 4x50m bifins.

5. CLASSIFICATION AND AWARDS:

According to CMAS Rules and Regulations.

Individualizes.

The first three classified athletes in every individual race and every relay by university teams medals receive medals.

9. REGISTRATION TUTORIAL

Registration Tutorial: For registration, you need an account, a University Team account, or a National Federation account.

- The Universities Teams have to create their account.
- The National federations receive their login information.

For event registration of your competitors, coaches, referees and officials, please follow these steps:

- Log in with your account
- Check your team data. Please check if the data is correct and up to date.
- Enter or change the data of your competitors, coaches, referees and officials.
- In the event calendar, go to the event you want to register for, click on the "Registration" button of the event you want to register.
- On the bottom of the entries site, you see the functions to make new entries.
- Register your competitors/teams in categories, as well as your coaches, referees and officials
- All your registrations go first on a waiting list to validate them. After the payment process is finished, your registrations are approved, and you are notified by email.

• You can find an overview of all your registrations at "My current entries". There you can also find the amount you have to pay and the provided payment method.

• Please also check out the "Other Items" section of the event. The organiser may also provide here additional purchase items, like transport, accommodation, etc.

BOOKING & ENTRY FEES

5 days: from Wednesday 07 to Sunday, July 11th (University competition only)

The entry fee per participant is **450,00** €. The organiser provides:

- Accommodation in three-star hotels with double or triple hotel rooms full board.
- Providing of 2x0,51 drinking water per pax/per day
- Free transfers between the official hotel and the swimming pool (training day include).

Extra charges:

- Transfers from international Tomsk airport to hotel and return, $40,00 \in$ per pax.
- Transfer from Novosibirsk international airport (280 km to Tomsk) to hotel and return, 100€/person.
- Extra charges for a single room ascend to $45,00 \in$ per pax per day.
- Extra day charged at 110,00 € per pax per day, including full board accommodation (breakfast, lunch, dinner, and water drink 0,5 l per meal included).

Participants who choose to be accommodated in hotels other than official have to pay 50 € per pax for secretarial fees, competition. No local transfers are provided.

Full board accommodation is considered breakfast, warm lunch, warm dinner, and water drink 0,51 per meal.

10.PAYMENT

The organiser accepts only cash or bank transfers in Euros (bank charges are billed to the sender). Bank checks and credit cards will not be accepted. A minimum of 50% of the total entry fee should be deposited at our bank no later than May 28rd 2021, to guarantee the booking. After May 28th 2021, the participation fees are increased by a further 10% of the total amount. The remaining amount should be preferably before July 5st 2021, in a bank transfer, and before the delegation arrival.

Bank check and credit card will not be accepted.
