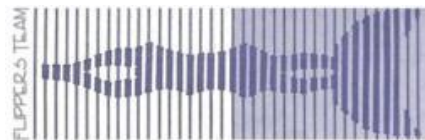

PARTICULAR REGULATION

1. PARTICIPATION RULES AND RACES

There is no limitation in the number of individual races enrolled. In order to promote finswimming, we can deliver upon request a temporary promotional sport licence for the two days of competition. The cost of the temporary sport licence is 15.- CHF per athlete. Athletes with swiss licence FSSS/SUSV will be in both Swiss Championships and Open International ranking. Athletes with a sport licence of a national federation recognised by CMAS other than FSSS/SUSV will be only in Open International ranking.

2. COMPETITION VENUE

This competition will be held in: «Centro Sportivo Tenero», Via Brere 10, CH-6598 Tenero.
Number of lanes: 8 - Length of pool: 50 meters long.

3. FINAL ENROLMENTS

The final enrolments must be made with the attached entry form and must be received before **Monday November 21st 2022** at the following email address: info@flippers.ch

The inscription fee: 25.00 CHF/EUR for club, 10.00 CHF/EUR each athlete.
Fee paid for not performed races will not be reimbursed.

4. FORFAIT OF COMPETITORS

The team leader will inform the judges of the absence of athletes before 14:00 on Saturday December 3rd 2022. For every swimmer absent in a heat without communication, the club will be liable for a fine of 50.00 CHF/EUR.

5. RACE JUDGES AND TIME REGISTRATION

The race will be directed by CMAS and SUSV/FSSS judges. Timekeepers with Swiss Timing Ares full electronic system.

6. PRICES

Medals will be given to the 3 best swiss athletes enrolled by swiss clubs on each race/category according to the swiss finswimming rules and to the 3 best athletes of the open international race. At the award ceremony each swimmer must wear his team uniform.

7. ANTIDOPING

WADA - World Antidoping Code, CMAS - Antidoping Rules, SUSV/FSSS - Antidoping Rules Athletes accept these rules as a condition of participation.

8. MEDIA

Media The competition may be covered by both photographers and video-cameras. By registering to the competition, you permit the organizer to publish such material on their website and/or other social media channels.

9. RESPONSIBILITY

SUSV/FSSS, the Competition Director, the Competition Officers and the Chief Judge are not responsible for accidents or damage caused to people and things before, during or after the competition.

10. SPECIAL NOTES

The present program could be modified for organization cause. Swimmers must present themselves to the Start Judge with their complete equipment at least 10 minutes before the race start. On request of the participating club the organizer can accept or refuse the participation of an athlete in individual races or of a relay not previously enrolled at any time at his discretion in- or outside the official classification. Any other rule concerning the competition can be found on the C.M.A.S. Finswimming Rules.
