



XVIII Finswimming World Cup 2024 ROUND 4



6-8 September 2024 Phuket, Thailand















1. Denomination

The Association of Thailand Underwater Sports (ATUS) – authorised by CMAS – invites all interested Federations and Clubs to participate in the XVIII CMAS Finswimming World Cup 2024, Round 4, organised 6 - 8 September 2024 in Phuket, Thailand.

2. Registration process

CMAS Finswimming Rules govern the competition, CMAS Finswimming World Cup Rules, and the present Specific Rules that every athlete - with his/her enrolment - affirms to know and agrees to follow strictly.

1. Registration

All athlete registration for events must be submitted only electronically.

Application forms can be used only for accommodation.

1.9 of rules: Each competitor can participate in a maximum of four (4) individual races and two (2) relays.

2. Registration Tutorial:

For registration, you need an account.

Users who already have registered an account <u>in our system</u>, please re-use your account. In this case, you can re-use all competitors', coaches', referees', and officials' data.

For event registration of your competitors, coaches, referees and officials, please follow these steps:

- Log in with your account
- Check your team data. Please check if the data is correct and up to date.
- Enter or change the data of your competitors, coaches, referees and officials.
- In the event calendar, go to the event you want to register for and click on the "Registration" button of the event you wish to register for.
- On the bottom of the entries site, you will see the functions to make new entries.









- Register your competitors/teams in categories, as well as your coaches, referees and officials
- All your registrations will go first on a waiting list in order to validate them. After the
 payment process is finished, your registrations will be approved and you will be
 notified by email.
- You can find an overview of all your registrations at "My current entries". There you can also find the amount you have to pay and the provided payment method.
- Please also check out the "Other Items" section of the event. The organiser may also provide here additional purchase items, like transport, accommodation, etc.

3. Fees of registration

a. CMAS Fees



For each round or Golden Final, in order to participate, each competitor must pay CMAS fees fixed annually by CMAS.

•24 € for participation fees by each round.

Please note that the names of relay members must be entered during the registration process on the base of individual registration even if they swim only relay and even according to the rules, the composition of relays can be changed on site before the beginning of competition.

These fees will be paid only at the end of the registration process online, by credit card.

b. Miscellaneous

- Fees paid for not performed races will not be reimbursed.



- Penalties will apply for late enrolments after the deadline according to the registration planning.

c. Organisation Fees

The procedures of all expenditures regarding the competition (accommodation fee, inscription fees etc.) are paid directly to the organising committee according to the instructions communicated below:

Inscription fees are:

- 24 € for each club;
- 17 € for each relay;
- 8,70 € for each individual distance:
- Fees paid for not performed races will not be reimbursed.
- Late enrolments are not accepted because registration is managed by CMAS system during registration planning.

4. Competition place

The competition will take place at:

Sport Complex PSU Phuket (Prince of Songkhla University, Phuket Campus) located in Phuket City, Thailand. (Website: https://sports.phuket.psu.ac.th)

The competition pool has;

- Length of 50 meters.
- Width of 25 meters
- 10 lanes
- Wave-breaking Lane ropes
- Permanent depth of 2 meters
- Water temperature 26°C (±1°C). Timing and Judging Consoles, Computerization and Touch Pads are provided by OMEGA Systems.











5. Timekeeping system

The timekeeper will conduct time recording through electronic time and recording system.

6. Checking equipment and bottle refills

The judges are authorised to control swimmers' equipment at any time during the competitions.

7. Classifications

Classifications will be based on times registered by the timekeepers, results will be complied according to CMAS score and CMAS World Cup classification.

- 3.1. There will be classifications for Individuals, Clubs, National Teams and Countries
- 3.2. <u>Individual</u>: There will be, for every distance, four different individual classifications for Senior and Junior, men and women. Swimmers registered by Clubs or National Teams are in this classification.
- 3.3. <u>Club</u>: The general classification will be made by the total amount of the individual points (men and women, junior and senior only registered by clubs). Four separate Club Classification will be made also for senior men, senior women, junior boys and junior girls.
- 3.4. <u>National Teams</u>: The general classification will be made by the total amount of the individual points (men and women, junior and senior). Four separate National Teams Classification will be made also for men, women, junior boys, junior girls.

3.5. Countries Ranking:

- 3.5.1. The Countries' Ranking will be made following points 0 and Error! Reference source not found. by the total amount of the individual points (men and women, junior and senior) of National Teams.
- 3.5.2. If a National Federation does not enrol its National team, the best two results by club following points 0 and Error! Reference source not found. at each distance, at each category (men, women, junior and senior) will go for the Countries ranking.

8. Prizes

Individual prizes: medals will be given to the first three classified athletes in every individual race and every relay.

Teams prizes: cups for the first three clubs and cups for the first three National Teams.

Awarding ceremonies will take place during the competition, so the involved athletes must be at the organising staff's disposal at the right time.









During ceremonies awarded athletes must wear the official uniforms of their teams.

9. Antidoping

- WADA World Antidoping Code
- CMAS Antidoping Rules
- Athletes accept these rules as a condition of participation.

Responsibility

The Organizing federation, the organising committee, CMAS, the Competition Director, Competition Officers and the Chief Judge aren't responsible for accidents or damage caused to people and personal effects before, during or after the competition.

10. Additional Note

The schedule of the program can be modified according to the needs of the organiser's judgment. Participating teams will get all information about the changes in time.

Swimmers must be available for the Start Judge with their full equipment at least 10 minutes before the race starts.

A. Team Accommodation

Accommodations and meals are being offered as a package to the participating delegations from the 5th September (from lunch) to 9th September (until Breakfast) or for 4 nights 12 meals.

- Accommodation for 4 nights (C/I: 05.09.24 C/O: 09.09.24)
 - Check-In Time: after 12:00 noon on the day of arrival.









- Check-Out Time: before 11:00 AM on the day of departure.
- Any departures after 12:00 noon will be subject to availability and possible additional charges.
- Extra days arriving earlier than 5th September 2024 and/or leaving after 9th September 2024 is offered in the following categories:
- Dara Hotel and Phuket Merlin Hotel is 60 \$ per person per day including breakfast, free Wi-Fi. and VAT.
- All team must stay during the Championship in the official hotels of the Championship. Participants who choose to be accommodated in hotels other than official will have to pay 300 USD per pax for Opening and Closing Ceremony and Organizing Fees.

B. Package Cost

• The package cost is billed PER INDIVIDUAL in single or double hotel rooms.



C. Transportation (Extra from the Package, the payment is for the team not individual)

- Number of 1-8 people in the team = 400 USD
- Number of 9-20 people in the team = 770 USD
- Number of 21-30 people in the team = 1,155 USD

The Package of Transportation will include;

- 1. Airport Hotel Airport on arrival and departure day
- 2. Hotel Swimming Pool Hotel (2 Round trips per day for 3 Days of Competitions on 7-9 September 2024)
