

# About Ibagué

Ibagué, known as the "Musical Capital of Colombia," is a vibrant and culturally rich city located in the central region of Colombia. Nestled in the Andean mountains at an elevation of approximately 1,285 meters (4,216 feet) above sea level, Ibagué enjoys a pleasant climate with average temperatures ranging from 18°C (64°F) to 28°C (82°F) throughout the year.

The city is famous for its musical heritage, hosting annual events like the Festival Folclórico Colombiano, which celebrates Colombian traditional music and dance. In addition to its musical traditions, Ibagué offers a variety of cultural, historical, and natural attractions. Visitors can explore its parks, museums, and nearby natural wonders, such as the Nevado del Tolima volcano and the Combeima Canyon. # Transportation to Ibagué

# 1. By Air

- Perales Airport (IBE): Ibagué is served by Perales Airport, which connects the city to Bogotá and other major Colombian cities. Direct flights from Bogotá's El Dorado International Airport (BOG) to Ibagué take approximately 40 minutes.
- o **International Travelers**: Most international travelers arrive in Colombia through Bogotá, Medellín, or Cali. From there, connecting flights to Ibagué are available.

# 2. By Road

- o From Bogotá: Ibagué is approximately 200 km (124 miles) west of Bogotá. The drive takes about 4-5 hours by car or intercity bus, depending on traffic and weather conditions. The route passes through scenic mountain landscapes, making it an enjoyable journey.
- From Medellín: The distance from Medellín to Ibagué is about 260 km (162 miles), and the drive takes roughly 6-7 hours.

#### 3. **By Bus**

O Ibagué has a well-connected bus terminal offering services from major Colombian cities. Bus companies provide frequent and affordable routes to the city.

Venue Details: Complejo Acuático - Parque Deportivo Ibagué

### Overview

The Complejo Acuático at Parque Deportivo Ibagué is a state-of-the-art aquatic center designed to host national and international competitions. Inaugurated in September 2024, this facility has quickly become a central hub for aquatic sports in Colombia.

# **Pool Specifications**

The complex features multiple pools tailored for various aquatic disciplines:

- **Competition Pool**: This Olympic-sized pool measures 50 meters in length and 25 meters in width, adhering to international standards for competitive finswimming events. The depth is 3 meters.
- **Training Pool**: A secondary pool designed for warm-ups and practice sessions. It measures 25 meters in length and 20 meters in width, with a uniform depth of 2 meters.

### **Facilities and Amenities**

The aquatic center is equipped with modern amenities to ensure a comfortable experience for athletes and spectators:

- **Seating Capacity**: The venue can accommodate up to 1,500 spectators, offering clear views of the competition area.
- **Locker Rooms**: Separate facilities for male and female athletes, each equipped with showers, restrooms, and secure lockers.
- **Medical Facilities**: On-site medical room staffed with professionals to address any health concerns during events, with ambulance on place and separated room for doping control tests.
- Accessibility: The complex is designed to be accessible, with ramps and designated seating areas for individuals with disabilities.


































# **General Rules**

- Only participants with a CMAS license are eligible to compete in the Championship.
- The registration of participants means that they accept and respect the championship rules, the safety conditions set by the organizers and the CMAS rules and regulations.
- Each country may enter a maximum of 2 athletes per age Senior category/discipline/men/women.
- Entries must be submitted to CMAS portal within deadlines <a href="https://portal.cmas.org/login">https://portal.cmas.org/login</a>.
- Registration must be done through National federation's account.
- If the National federation has not yet an account must contact the CMAS HelpDesk.
- Pan-American Seniors Championship will occur over 3 competition days.
- Age Categories are as defined at the relevant CMAS finswimming rules.

#### **INMERSION BOTTLES INFO**

According to CMAS rules, all bottles used must have passed a hydrostatic test less than 2 years before the competition dates.

Each swimmer must bring their own adapter for charging their bottles.

Please check before the competition:

- b) Check that they are within the period of validity of the periodic inspection and the visual inspection.
- c) Check the external condition of the cylinder and the valve.
- d) Check that the valve matches the one identified in the last periodic inspection certificate, or, if no periodic inspection has been carried out, in the cylinder manufacturing documentation.

If a cylinder does not comply with the requirements established in this ITC, the refilling company may not carry out the refill.

# **DOPING CONTROL**

Anti-doping tests will be conducted during the championship according to the international rules of WADA and the CMAS anti-doping code.

The organizing committee guarantees to provide doping control according to the CMAS and WADA rules.

# **MEDICAL SERVICES**

Medical doctors will be present during the competition and will provide first aid.

For more serious health issues, an ambulance will be outside the venue to transfer to the nearest state hotel. Health issues and need for hospital care from places other than the swimming pool must be taken care by the teams or by each person.

Medical and hospital expenses are upon teams-athletes.

# RESPONSIBILITY

The Organizing, CMAS AMERICA, FEDECAS, the organizing committee, CMAS, the Competition Director, Technical CMAS Delegate, Competition Officers and the Chief Judge are not responsible for accidents or damage caused to people and personal effects before, during or after the competition.



















Athlete, coach, delegates, officials' competition fees are **550 USD Dollar** per person as Organizing Fees.

Include registration, Hotel Check in - August 20 - Check out August 24 with 3 meals, Transportation Airport -hotel - hotel airport - internal transportation during competition event. Accommodations in double or triple rooms.

If you want to be outside of the organizer the fee is 300 USD per person.

Must send 50% certification payment for the reservation (availability depending on early reservation), The organizer only accepts bank transfer for this payment (bank charges will be charged to the remitter). Bank checks or credit cards will not be accepted.

If you want a single room, you must pay an additional 40 USD per day.

Extra cost day is 110 USD per day.

Officials, coaches, assistants, visitors, reporters, viewers etc. must be registered and accredited to enter the pool.

#### **PAYMENTS**

Full amount should be transferred to LOC no later **than July 15<sup>th</sup> 2025.**After this date, the participation fees will increase by a further 15% of the total amount. The remaining payment should be paid upon arrival.

Receipts of the payments will be available at the competition time. We need **full data** (name of organization, full address, Tel) and copy of the transfer, to create the receipts and/or invoices.

If it is need for a receipt earlier or upon transfer, you must send a requesting email with full data of the organization-athlete and a copy of the transfer.

#### REFUND POLICY

- 1) Requesting Removal from the competition
- 1a. Teams or athletes requesting to be removed from the competition need to do so via email to LOC, by the team leader of the team. We will use the date and time as verification to when the request was sent. Phone calls, messages and texts will not be accepted.
- 1b. Any team or athlete that requests to be removed from the competition, before 30 days of the start date of the competition, will be removed with no administration fees accessed and full refund.
- 1c. Any team that requests removal from the competition 30 days or less from the start date, will have a 100 USD per person, administration fee, deducted from their entry fee. The refund will be 50% at the remaining amount.
- 1d. No refund will be issued for hotel or transfer expenses if less than 30 days.



















- 2) No refund will be issued to any team or athlete that requests removal from the competition 10 days or less from the start date of the competition.
- 3) None paid teams or athletes, will not be allowed to participate until the fee is paid.
