# WELCOME TO TUNIS

**Tunis, the capital and largest city of Tunisia, is located on the Gulf of Tunis, nestled between Lake Tunis and the port of La Goulette.**

**As the political and administrative heart of the country, Tunis plays a central role in Tunisia's commercial and cultural life.**

**The city's architecture reflects its rich history, shaped by civilizations ranging from the Phoenicians and Romans to the Arabs, Ottomans, and French.**

**One of its most iconic landmarks is the Zitouna Mosque, the largest of its kind in Tunisia. Dating back to the 8th century, it has long been a defining feature of the city's skyline**



**Carthage was an ancient Phoenician city located in present-day Tunisia, about 15 km from the center of Tunis. Founded in the 9th century BCE, it became a powerful maritime empire and a major rival of Rome. The city was known for its advanced trade network, naval power, and military strength, especially during the Punic Wars. Carthage was ultimately destroyed by Rome in 146 BCE but later rebuilt as a Roman colony. Today, its ruins are a UNESCO World Heritage Site, showcasing remnants of its rich history and influence.**



**Sidi Bou Said is a picturesque coastal village in Tunisia, located about 20 km from the center of Tunis. 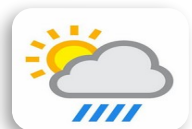

In September, Tunis experiences warm and pleasant weather. Temperatures typically range from 20°C to 32°C (68°F to 90°F), with cooler evenings. The month is mostly sunny, with little rainfall, making it ideal for outdoor activities.



Tunis follows Central European Time (CET, UTC+1) year-round



In Tunisia, the power plugs used are Type C and Type E.  
Voltage: 220-240V at 50 Hz



Tunisian currency is the Tunisian Dinar (TND)  
Around from 0.30 to 0.29 Euro and from 0.31 to 0.33 Dollard

## Competition Venus

### **Olympic swimming Pool of Rades : 50m indoor**

This aquatic complex with capacity of 500 spectators.

The indoor competition swimming pool is a 50m and 10 lanes pool with 2metres depth and overage temperature from 24C to 28C.

The indoor competition swimming pool include

Four Changing rooms for Teams and Two Changing rooms for Officials

The indoor swimming pool include also a small swimming pool ( 25m/10m) and many rooms for preparation , operation and meeting .





# Competition Venus

- **Open Water**

- **Course set up** : the lake's calm waters allow for easy course setup , ensuring a fair and safe competition

- **Safety** : the lake's sheltered location and calm waters reduce the risk of accidents , ensuring a safe environment for competitors

- **Spectator viewing** :the lake shearline offers ample space for spectators to watch the competition, providing an exciting and immersive experience.





# Official Accommodation

## Hotel Ez-Zahra Dar Tunis

**This property is just a 2-minute walk from the beach.**

# General Information

•The competition will take place in the olympic swimming pool of Rades and Lake of Tunis Aquatic club from 2nd to 7th September 2025

## •Information about Participation :

- Only participants with a CMAS license and ADEL certificate are eligible to compete in this competition.
- All participants should respect the competition rules, the safety conditions set by the organizers and CMAS rules and regulations.
- Athletes participating in the 2025 CMAS Arab and Africa Finswimming Indoor and Outdoor Championships are not allowed to compete in the 2025 CMAS African and Arab Finswimming Age Group Competition (CMAS procedures and obligations).
- Athletes from countries without a CMAS-affiliated federation (NF) can participate individually, as long they are nationals of a CMAS member country and obtain a 'Super License' from CMAS (CMAS procedures and obligations).
- For individual races, each team may enter a maximum two(2) finswimmers and one (1) relay team for each categories.
- For relay races the names of the finswimmers and their starting order must appear in a list submitted to the result office before the start of the session.
- The composition of mixed relays is with two (2) males and two (2) females ,And starting order in Man -Woman-Man-Woman.
- Any change in the fixed starting order leads to disqualification





# General Information

## Categories :

- Category C=14-15 years
- Category D=12-13 years

## Swimming Pool events :

- Surface =50m -100m -200m and 400m
- Bifins = 50m -100m -200m and 400m
- Relay Mixed = 4x100m Surface and 4x50m Bifins

## Open water events :

- Surface =500m
- Bifins = 500m

The championship will be only direct final in the morning sessions.

## Classification & Awards :

For the 2025 African and Arab Age Group Finswimming competition , awarding ceremony will be done in the morning sessions.

The medal ceremony will be merged into a single ceremony for both Arab and African classification.

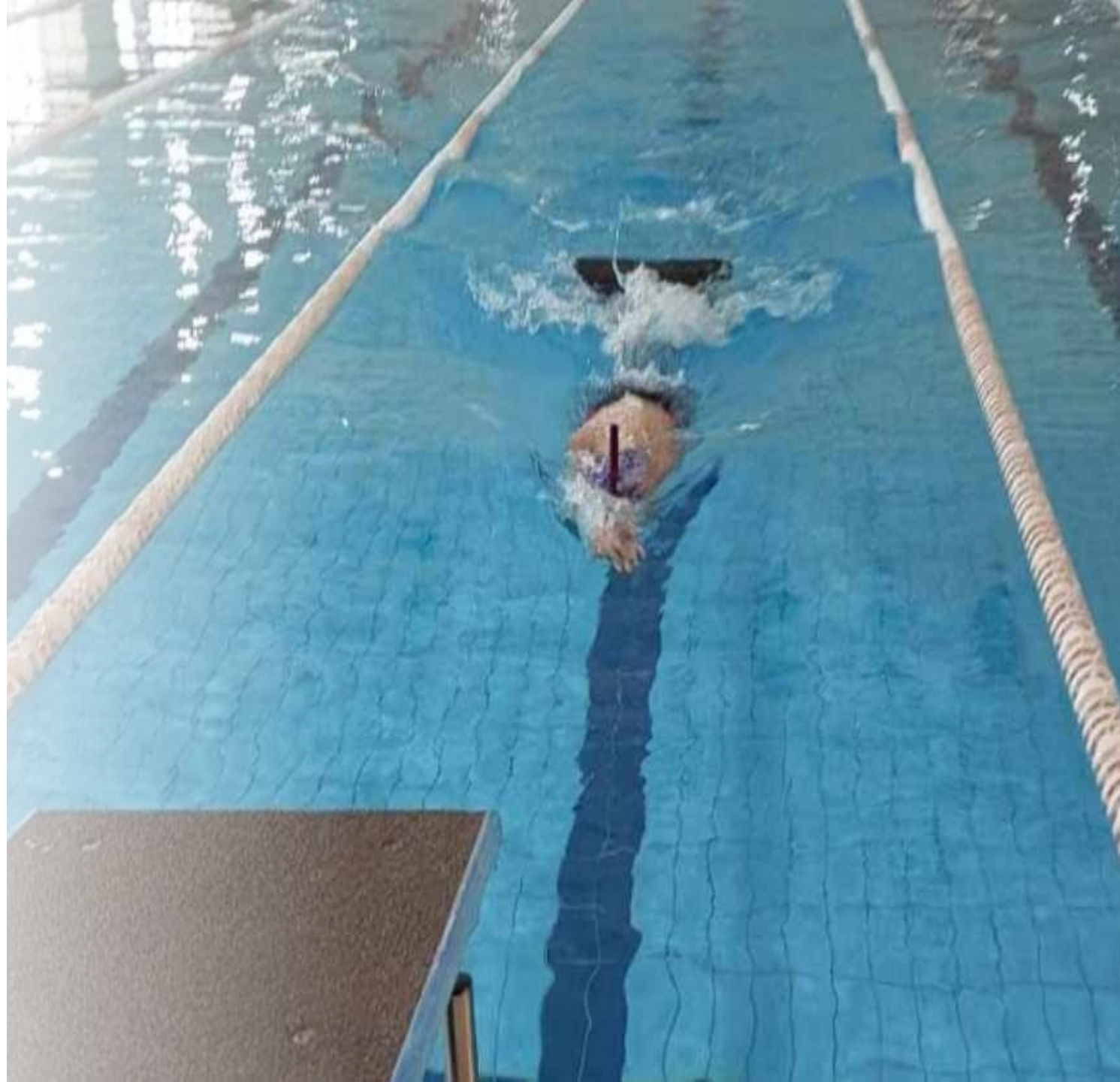
- 1st place = gold medal

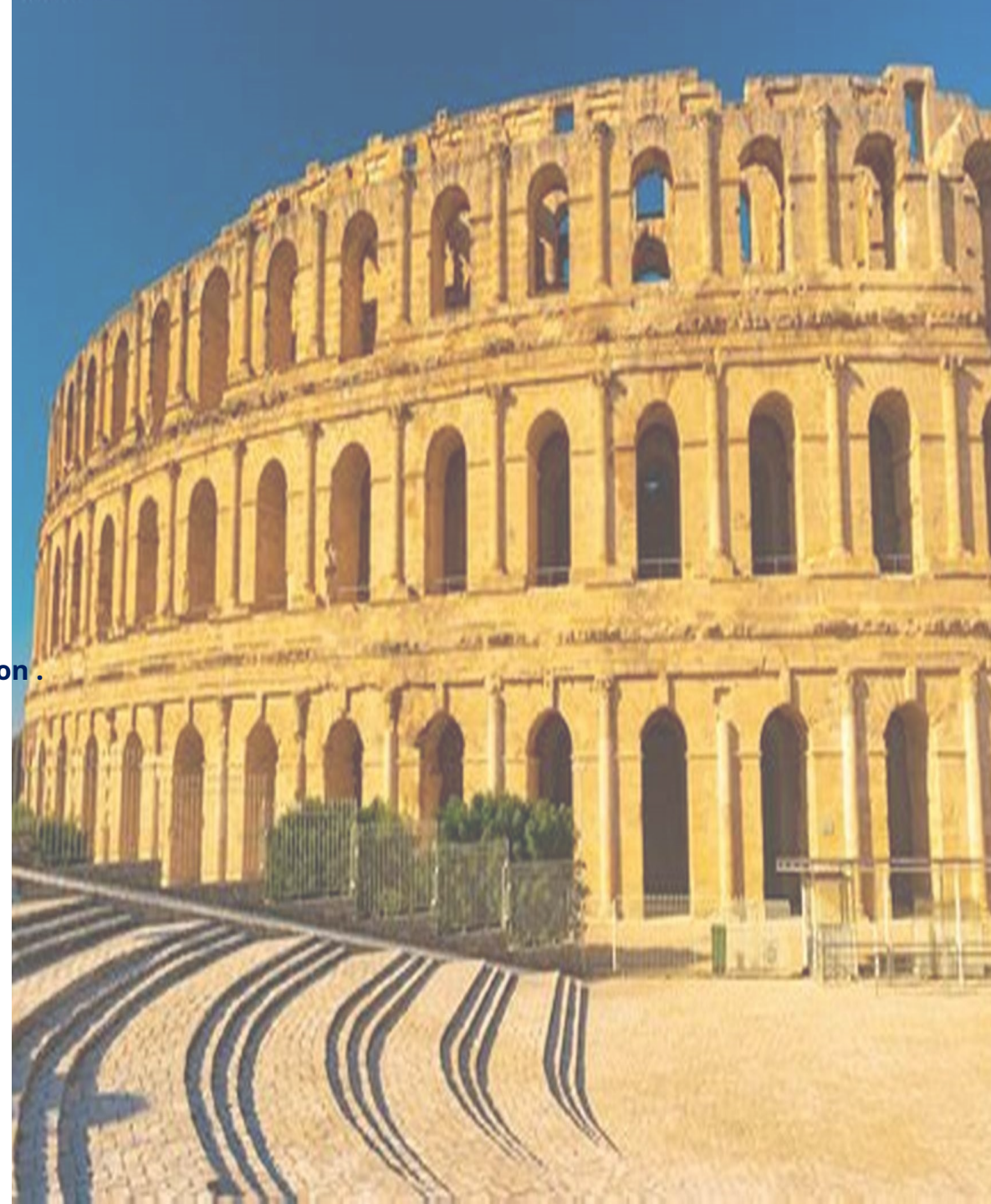
